Snake River Music Gardens is accepting applications for one-year residencies for its education program, MAHA Farms and Ranches. Successful applicants will be interviewed and carefully matched with a mentor/farmer/rancher/gardener. Mentor and resident will sign a residency agreement, for a resident to trade one year of work in ranching, farming, gardening, or forestry for one year of mentoring and hands-on apprenticeship. Residents will emerge with experience and tools in one or more occupations in the natural resource-based economy, ready to work as a producer.

Steps to apply for a residency:
